Check this box if the amount you are paying is less than the total amount of the overpayment or debt. When the amount paid is less than the total amount due, interest is assessed each month on the unpaid balance. Penalties and other charges may also be added. The Railroad Retirement Board (RRB) will treat a payment of less than the total amount due as a monthly installment payment.

If a monthly installment agreement does not already exist for this account, the RRB will assume you are requesting an agreement. The RRB will also assume the amount being paid is the minimum amount you agree to pay each month. The amount paid each month must be large enough to recover the total amount due in a reasonable period of time. In a few days, a debt specialist will contact you to discuss the request for an installment agreement. You must provide a phone number where the specialist will be able to reach you between the hours of 9:00 a.m. and 3:30 p.m. Central Time.
